The Barcelona School of Economics (BSE) organizes the Tenth BSE Summer Forum. The Summer Forum is a series of independent workshops that cover the main fields of economics. The Summer Forum 2023 will take place from June 6 to June 20, 2023. The venue will be the Balmes Building (Balmes 132) in central Barcelona.

### ENTREPRENEURSHIP

The workshop will run for 1.5 days and will take place on 15-16 June 2023, in Barcelona.

Entrepreneurship claims a central role in economics and management as a wellspring of industrial dynamism, innovation, and wealth creation. Building on early contributions by scholars such as Joseph Schumpeter, Frank Knight, or William Baumol, researchers, policy makers, and managers alike seek to uncover the economic incentives and personal motivations that affect entrepreneurial behavior in new ventures or established organizations. Moreover, independent and corporate venture capital have recently become key to business dynamism and long-term growth.

The keynote speaker for this workshop is **Olav Sorenson**, the Joseph Jacobs Chair in Entrepreneurial Studies at UCLA's Anderson Graduate School of Management and a department editor at *Management Science*.

We welcome empirical and theoretical submissions at the cutting edge of entrepreneurship from both experienced and promising young scholars in the field. Relevant topics include, but are not limited to: new venture creation, dynamics of entrepreneurial careers, start-up strategy, entrepreneurial human capital,



entrepreneurial finance and venture capital, corporate entrepreneurship, institutions and entrepreneurship.

The deadline for submissions is **February 28, 2023**. To submit a paper, please use this link <https://app-summerforum.bse.eu/>. Submissions should include either a full paper or an extended abstract with the main results. Authors chosen to present papers will be notified approximately by the end of March. A preliminary program will be announced by the end of April.

Please note that the BSE Summer Forum is a series of independent workshops. When you submit your paper, you will be able to see the topics and dates of other workshops that will take place within the Summer Forum. The same paper **cannot be submitted to more than one workshop**, but you are welcome to submit a different paper to another workshop.

There is no registration fee and meals during the workshop will be provided for participants. The workshop organizers will not be able to provide accommodation or travel support for speakers.
