Requirements

- A doctoral degree in Business Administration or neighboring fields such as Applied Economics, Industrial Engineering and Management, or in other business relevant fields.
- Given the strong research orientation of the chair candidates needs to have excellent knowledge in quantitative, qualitative, or simulation methods.
- Excellent command of English (oral and written).
- Applicants should show a strong potential to publish research results in international top journals demonstrated, for instance, by published paper, under review or accepted at conferences and have developed a research program of international stature.

The earliest possible start date is September 1, 2019 with a later start date possible upon agreement. The position is initially for three years with the possibility to extend for an additional three years upon positive evaluation (3+3 years).
